Register for Child Protection Risk Management workshops

A free child protection risk management workshop will be held in Gladstone on Tuesday 1 May for people who provide regulated child-related services.

Organisations regulated by the *Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian Act 2000* are encouraged to attend the workshop and enhance their understanding of risk management to protect children and young people from harm.

The workshop, run by the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian will explain the purpose of a child protection risk management strategy and what it means in practice.

Participants in the workshop will learn to assess the risk management strategies they currently have in place, and understand how to address any gaps in their policies, training and risk management systems.
